Position Summary: MAISA is seeking an Application Developer who will work within the MiCH IT development team. The Application Developer is an experienced developer who is responsible for developing, maintaining, and deploying cloud-hosted, web-based applications. The developer will work as part of an agile software development team that works on web-based, cloud-hosted applications that service school districts across the state of Michigan.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- Development and maintenance, and deployment of multiple applications with various technology stacks
- Use a behavior-driven approach to software development
- Create and maintain a robust collection of unit, front-end and integration test suites for applications they work on
- Create and maintain technical documentation
- Monitor and address application performance & defect reports via tracking software
- Working with and modifying CI/CD processes on a per-project basis
